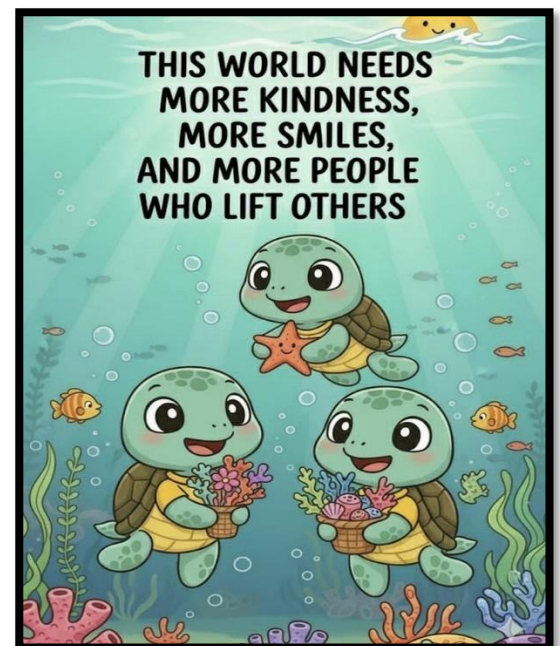
Dear All,
